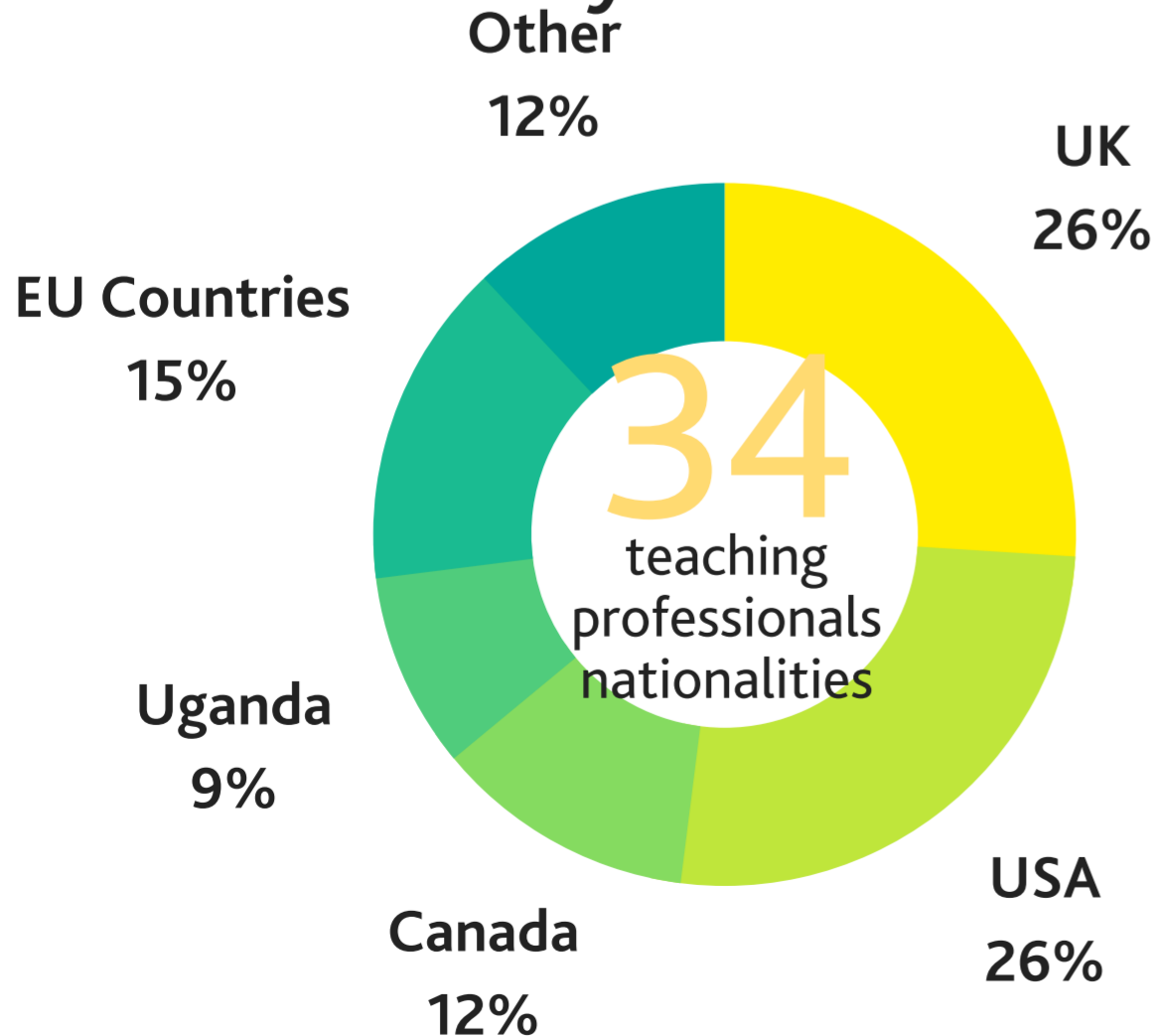

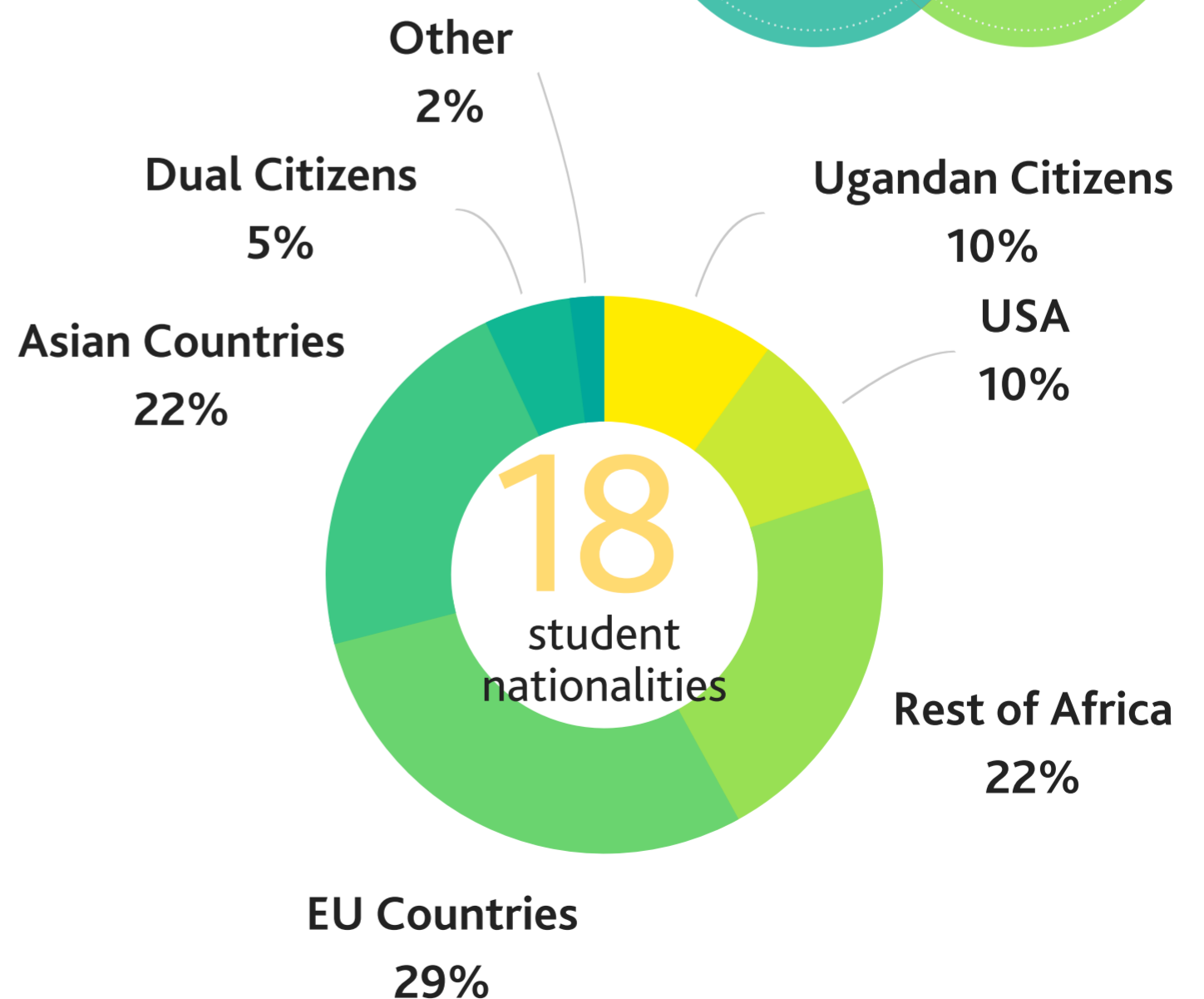

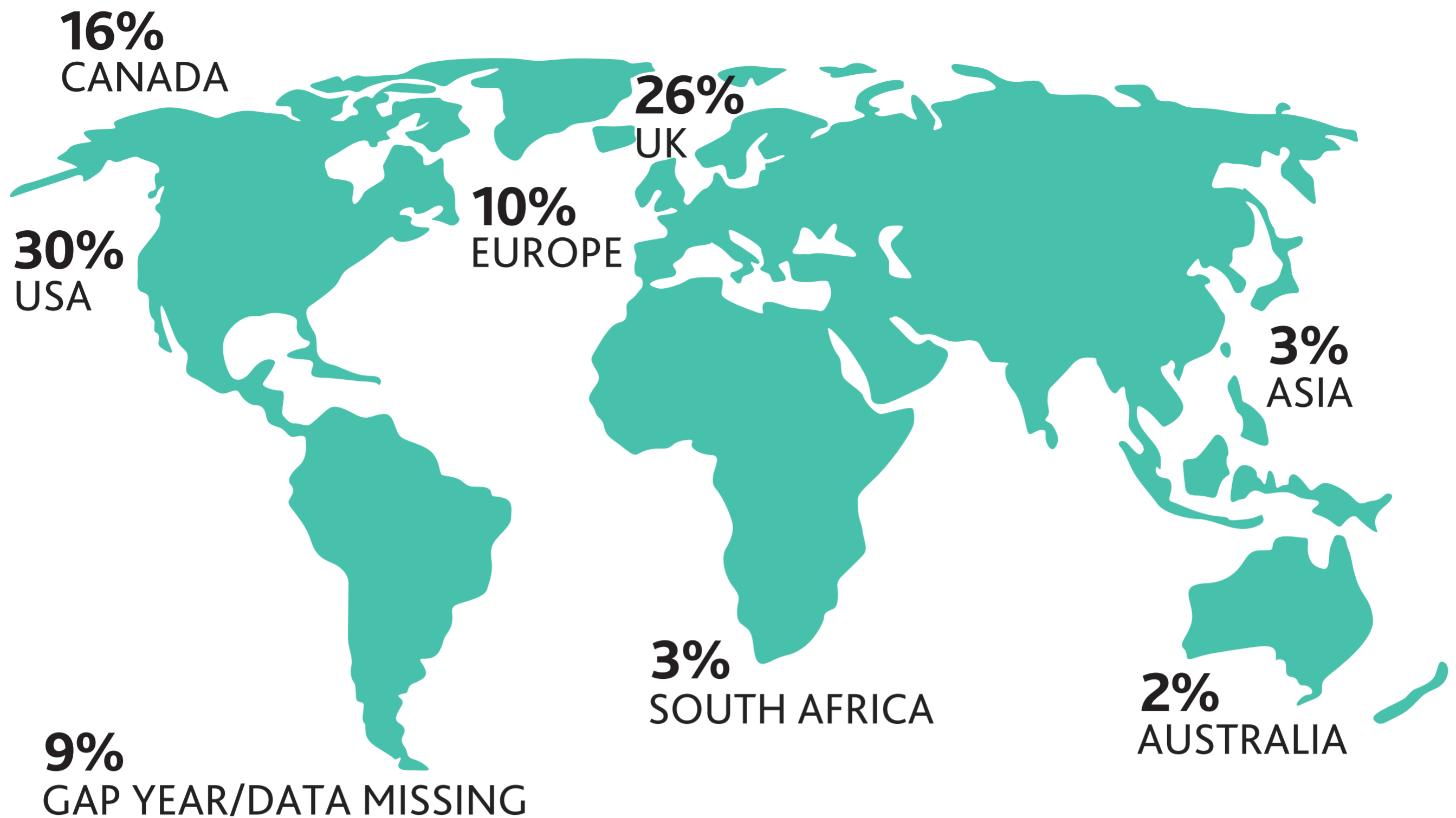

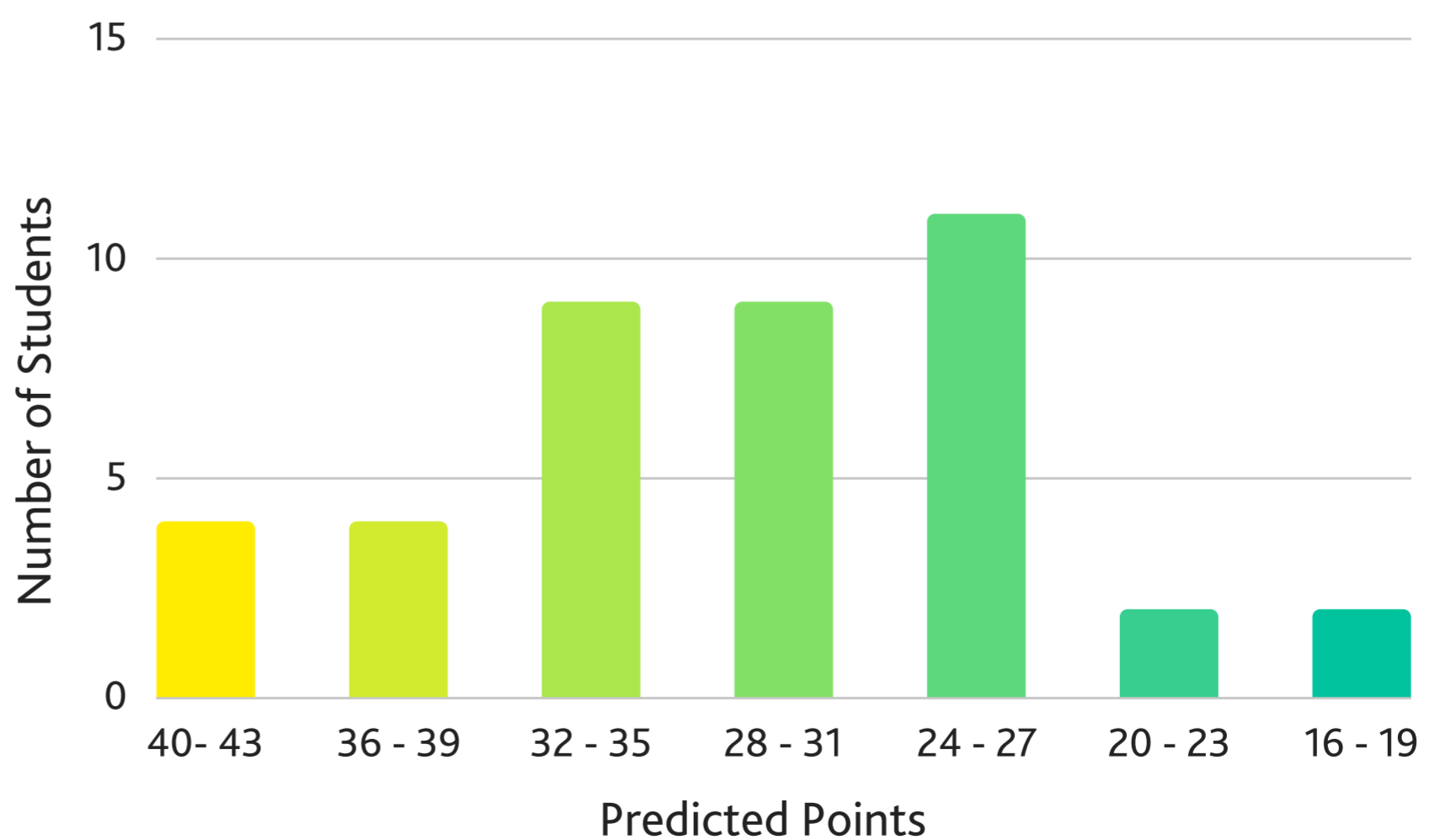

Creativity, Action, Service Program (CAS)

As an IB World School, ISU requires all Diploma and Courses students to participate in the CAS program as an extension of their academics. ISU offers a number of opportunities to help our students meet these requirements.

ISSEA & ISSAK Competitions

ISU is a member of the International Schools of Southern and Eastern Africa (ISSEA), which is a league of eight international schools from eight African nations. Teams compete in volleyball, track, basketball, football, swimming, tennis, golf, rugby, choir, drama, visual art and STEM. ISU is also a member of a local competitive sports league, International Schools Sports Association Kampala (ISSAK), which includes volleyball, basketball, football, swimming and track and field competitions. Our students prepare for competitions after school and on weekends.

Other Activities

After School Activities are planned to be an extension of learning for our students. Activities are run by teachers, students or other members of the community. The activities offered at ISU include the above leagues as well as Model United Nations (MUN), student council, fitness classes, band, boxing, tutoring others, service opportunities and yearbook.

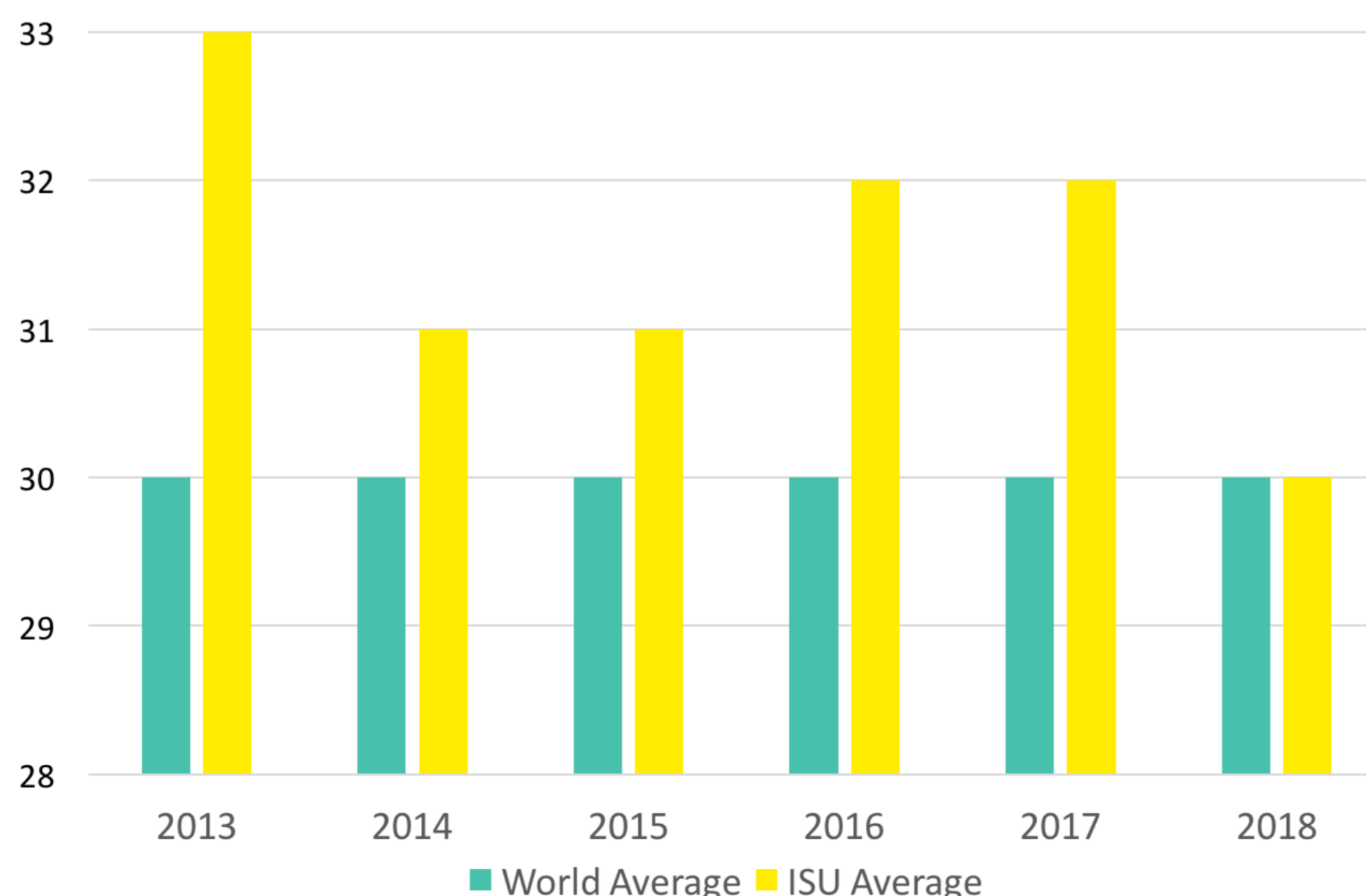
IB Grading Scale
