## History

- Founded in 1967
- Independent, non-profit, day school ages 3 - 19 years
- Non-selective admissions to all IB Programmes

## Community

- 615 students
- 367 in Senior School (Grades 6 - 12)
- 53 nationalities
- 38% of students are non-native English speakers
- 53 languages spoken
- 45 teaching professionals in Senior School
- 2 - 4 years is the average time families stay in Uganda making for a multicultural, fluid, and diverse community.

## Academics

- IB Continuum School: PYP, MYP, DP
- All instruction is in English
- High School Diploma awarded to all students that earn the equivalent of a 3 or above in 23 courses during Grades 9-12
- ISU uses a block schedule on an 8-day rotation
- Due to our small graduating classes and the diversity of educational backgrounds from which our students come, **we do not rank nor provide a GPA** for our students

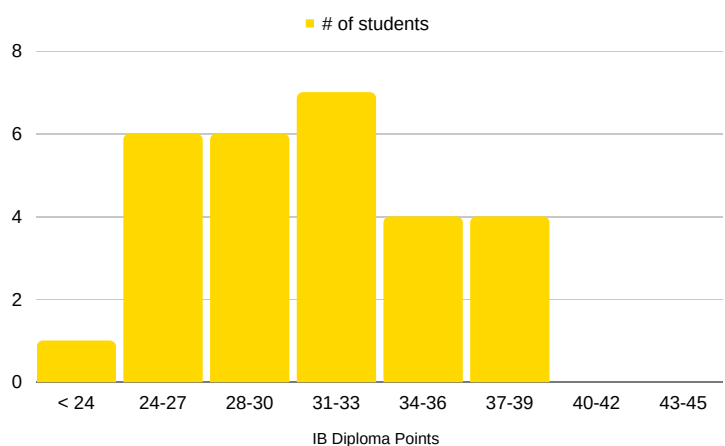
## COVID-19 Statement

On March 19, 2020, ISU students began virtual learning and finished the school year online. For the 2020-2021 school year, we began virtual learning in August, but hybrid lessons started in mid-October, 2020 virtually. The school remained open until June 3, with some temporary closures due to Covid cases on campus. Our final two weeks of the school year were virtual. For the 2021-2022 school year, school began virtually on August 16th. We were able to reopen for the Grade 11 students at the end of September 2021, and we have remained open since. As a result of virtual learning in fall, 2020, some classes were graded on a Pass/Fail basis for the first semester of Grade 9.

## IB DP Points Distribution - Class of 2023



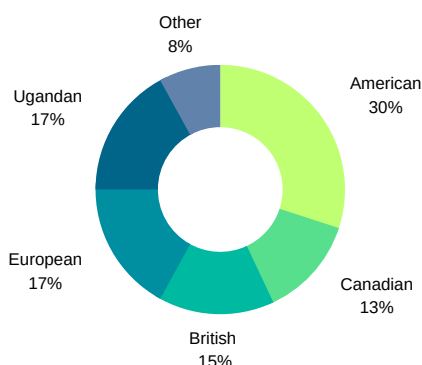

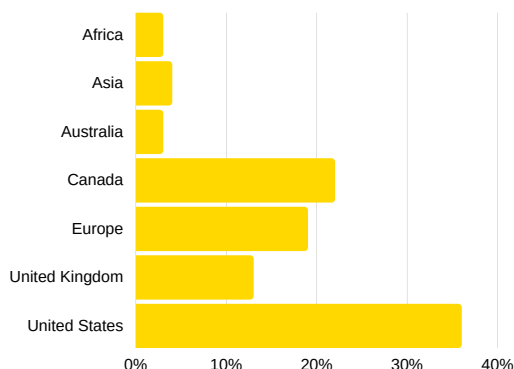
# Creativity, Activity, Service Program (CAS)

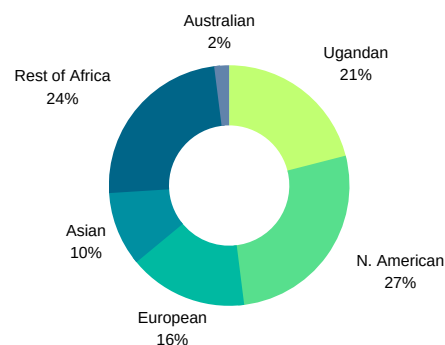
