# **History**

- Founded in 1967
- Independent, non-profit, day school ages 3 19 years
- Non-selective admissions to all IB Programmes
- Accredited by IBO, CIS and MSA CESS

## Community

- 554 students (Whole School: Grades P-12) 212 students (Senior School: Grades 9-12)
- 56 nationalities
- 25% of students are non-native English speakers 44 teaching professionals (Senior School: Grades 9–12)
- 2-4 years is the average time families stay in Uganda, making for a multicultural, fluid, and diverse community.

### **Academics**

- All instruction is in English
- IB Continuum School: PYP, MYP, DP
- ISU uses a block schedule on an 8-day rotation
- US-style High School Diploma, accredited by MSS CESS, awarded to all students who earn the equivalent of a 3 or above in 23 courses during Grades 9-12
- Due to our small graduating classes and the diversity of educational backgrounds from which our students come, we do not rank nor provide a GPA for our students


To increase the breadth of educational offerings at ISU, we support self-taught courses offered by recognized online providers. Students choosing to undertake IB SSST courses and ISU Online Electives as part of their schedule may come from any of our Academic Pathways; however, they incur an additional fee.

Students who undertake ISU Online Electives are graded as pass or fail on the ISU transcript and are awarded ISU credit for a passing grade. Final scores are awarded only by the ISU-recognized provider, and their certificates of achievement are attached to the ISU transcript. ISU-recognized online providers of credit-awarding coursework include Brigham Young University (BYU) Independent Study, University of Nebraska High School (UNHS), Excel High School, and other credit-awarding providers deemed appropriate by the ISU administration. *Note: Students who undertake additional online coursework* outside the regular school day do not have these courses listed on their ISU

# **IB DP Points Distribution - Class of 2025**





















# Creativity, Activity, Service Program (CAS)

As an IB World School, ISU requires all Grade 11 and 12 students to participate in the CAS Program as an extension of their academics, regardless of their diploma pathway. Students have the opportunity to participate in sports, the arts, and STEAM competitions internationally through the International Schools of Southern and Eastern Africa (ISSEA) league, as well as competing in a smaller, local league. A range of after-school activities is offered, including the Global Citizens Diploma, Duke of Edinburgh, Model United Nations, Student Council, and numerous other academic and non-academic pursuits. Service opportunities are also available, taking place on the school campus and in the local community.


# Faculty Nationalities (P-12)
